



HUNT AT TEJON

Trophy Elk Hunt

Tejon Ranch is consistently ranked as one of the top Rocky Mountain Elk hunting destinations in the United States; mild winters, abundant feed, and very limited hunting pressure allow the elk to flourish. Located just an hour and a half north of Los Angeles you will find yourself in some of the best elk hunting habitat found in the world.

Our trophy elk hunts are a six day, six night hunt (hunt to harvest applies) including lodging, meals, transportation on the ranch, basic field care of game and transportation to the local taxidermist and meat processor. One (non-hunter) guest is also included with this hunt. This is a one-on-one guided hunt with an assistant guide helping to scout the 270,000 acre ranch for trophy bulls. Tejon Ranch offers a guaranteed shot opportunity on a bull measuring 350" (Gross) or better Boone & Crockett. Shot guarantee is at the guide's discretion on score and reasonable shooting distance. We are confident that we will find a bull of true trophy caliber.

Schedule:

Hunts typically start at (3:00 pm) on the day of arrival at the Tejon Ranch Wildlife Management Office (4427 Lebec Rd. Lebec, CA 93243). After checking in you will be escorted to your hunting cabin by your guide or another ranch representative where you will receive an orientation. A shooting range is available to ensure your rifle or bow is on target. You will then sit down for a nice dinner and get ready for the hunt to begin the following morning. You can generally expect to hunt the morning's until the elk activity has slowed and again in the afternoon. There will be a lull in the middle of the day that will allow you the time to rest and prepare for the afternoon hunt. We will be sitting down to early dinners this time of the year allowing us to stay out until last light maximizing the best hunting hours. This schedule will continue through the morning hunt of the last day when we will exit the ranch.

What to Bring:

Hunters are expected to come prepared for vast and varying terrain, changing weather patterns, and basic needs to care for game transportation when leaving the ranch. Our cabins are equipped with all the basic needs including hot showers, towels, bedding and provide a great atmosphere for hunters to enjoy their time on the ranch. All meals will be provided (excluding alcohol). Please note, Tejon Ranch requires **non-lead ammunition** for your firearm and a valid California hunting license in order to hunt on the ranch. Your "PLM" elk tag is included in the cost of your hunt. At Tejon Ranch, we strive to not only make your hunting experience successful, but memorable as well.

Hunt Price: \$30,000 (Includes PLM Tag)

Deposit and Cancellation Policy:

All hunts require a 50% (Non-Refundable) deposit at booking unless otherwise specified, with the balance due on arrival. Any cancellation needs to be in writing (fax or email) and needs to be received by the Tejon Ranch Wildlife Management Department within (72) hours of the scheduled date of the hunt. If proper notification is received within the allotted (72) hour timeframe your deposit may be rolled into another available hunt for the current hunting season. If proper notification of cancellation is not received in the allotted timeframe or you fail to show up for your scheduled hunt any deposit will be forfeited.

Note: Any hunt being booked more than one (1) year in advance may be subject to price increase of up to 20% for the year or season for which the hunt will take place.
